Minutes:

Website:

The signs for the park area will be installed on November 14th during the park cleanup.

He confirmed that the Bethel Landscaping contract was signed for 2016.

George said that he was still looking to get a couple bids to repair the park walking trails to make them safer for the neighborhood to use.

George indicated that the response for the park cleanup looked good that he expected a good turnout for the event.

Board Candidates 2016:

It was noted that the annual election of board members was coming up and that, in addition to the six current members running, three additional candidates will be included on the ballot. Ballots will be sent to the homeowners shortly via email.

Other Business:

It was pointed out that the new home being built on the lot by the main entrance might have part of the PPPOA's sprinkler system on the property. George will look into this to see what, if anything, needs to be done and report back to the board in December.

It was mentioned that homeowners dues for 2016 would have a slight increase from \$425 to \$450 to cover any additional maintenance and repair expenditures that might come up. It was felt this increase was needed to maintain the property as it is aging and keeping a reserve.
